2022-2023 Dress Code

- **Parents**, please make sure your student is dressed appropriately before leaving for school. If a student is out of dress code, the student will be given the opportunity to comply. If the student is unable to comply, the parent will be contacted to come and get the student and the day will not count.



Shirts – Collared, no logos. Undershirts must be solid white and free of designs. Shirts can be white, black, or gray.



Pants - Khaki slacks. Colors can be light khaki, dark khaki, or black. The pants must be “slacks” two front pockets and two back pockets. No side pockets or carpenter/cargo pants allowed. Pants may not be excessively tight or loose, may not have designs or bling on the pockets, and the bottoms may not be cuffed or pegged. Jogging pants are acceptable.



Shoes – Must be black or white athletic shoes with black or white laces. ALL parts of shoe, including sole, must be black or white. **(No other colors)**



Socks – Must be solid white or black. **(No other colors)**

Transportation
